- ❖ The fee for a painted parking spot is \$50.00 and is due at Tiger Days. The money collected goes towards project graduation activities. You can pay by cash or check. Please make checks out to Armada High School and on the memo line write 'painted parking spot'.
- ❖ Students must still purchase the year-long parking permit required by the school.
- ❖ **A parking lot space design request form must be filled out and approved by the HS principal, Mr. Kastl.**
- ❖ **Please turn in your design to Mrs. Obry before August 15, 2025.** The drawings can be submitted to lisaobry@gmail.com or through a private chat on Band.
- ❖ You **cannot** paint your parking spot if your design is not approved. ***When designing your parking spot – think of your parking space as a t-shirt you would wear to school...***
- ❖ The design must meet the dress code approval.
- ❖ Any design associated with gangs, drugs, alcohol, violence, obscene slogans or symbols, handicap symbols, or symbols that may cause confusion or promote illegal activities will not be allowed or approved.
- ❖ You may include your name, jersey number, band instrument, hobby, famous quotes, or slogans and/or anything unique to you that will meet administrative approval.
- ❖ **“2026” should be clearly painted near the bottom of the design.**

PAINT GUIDELINES – You must meet the below guidelines, please check when purchasing.

- ✓ WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT is the only paint that can be used.
- ✓ No reflective paint.
- ✓ No spray paints.
- ✓ No fluorescent paint.

Students are responsible for all paint, brushes, rollers, paint pans and paint tape. Do not bring any kind of sprayer or clear coat. All students must clean-up properly and dispose of all paint and equipment. You may want to bring cones and rope to block off your space while it dries.
