DRIVING REGULATIONS

The following regulations pertain to student drivers requesting driving/parking privileges at Armada High School.

- 1. Students must observe all Michigan traffic laws and commonly accepted rules of courtesy while driving to and from school, while on school grounds, and while attending all school-related activities. Reports of dangerous driving enroute to/from school can result in loss of parking permit.
- 2. Student drivers must immediately register their car with the high school main office and update all changes (license plate, new vehicle information, etc.)
- 3. Students may NOT drive during noon/lunch hour, or during the regular school day, without specific permission from parent/guardian and authorized and approved by the Principal or Assistant Principal.
- 4. NO loitering in vehicle during regular school hours.
- 5. Vehicles are to be parked in designated student (orange) spaces, within the lines.
- 6. Hang tag/parking permit must be in clear view, attached to the backside of the rearview mirror.
- 7. School buses always have the right-of-way.
- 8. Student drivers may not allow others to ride in the back of their pick-up or on trailers.
- 9. Reckless driving is very serious. Students may face suspension, police intervention, and/or loss of permit.
- 10. Armada Area Schools are not responsible for damage, theft, or unauthorized entry of vehicles.
- 11. A 15 MPH speed limit is always in force on school grounds.
- 12. A student vehicle found containing (or occupants using) illegal substances will result in loss or parking permit along with police citation.
- 13. Vehicles parked on school grounds may be searched by administration.
- 14. ATVs, unlicensed motorbikes, tractors, snowmobiles, and other recreational vehicles are not allowed to be driven or parked on school grounds without prior authorization for special events.
- 15. Vehicles must have a valid license plate and be in safe operating condition.

PARKING PERMIT PRICING:

\$30 = full year, Aug - June

\$20 = Tri 2 - June (Dec 2 - June)

\$10 = Tri 3 - end of year (March 10 - June)

PARKING VIOLATIONS and FINES:

Improper display/failure to display permit - \$5

Double-parked, not with-in lines - \$5

Parking in prohibited area (staff lot/visitor designated spaces) - \$10

Parking on grass/sidewalk - \$10

Unauthorized handicapped parking (24-hour enforcement) - \$50

Fines paid within 24-hours of ticket being issued are discounted by 50%

Fines are to be paid in the in the main office within one week of issue. Failure to pay fine in this time period will result in suspension of parking permit until fine is paid.

VEHICLES FOUND WITHOUT A CURRENT YEAR PERMIT or SUSPENDED PERMIT:

First offense: Warning ticket

Second offense: \$15 fine (not to be applied toward purchase of permit)

Third offense: Vehicle towed at owner's expense.

Vehicle information, including license plate number, will be recorded upon issue of violation. Students driving alternate vehicles must alert HS office immediately upon entering building to avoid being ticketed.

Failure to comply with any/all the above regulations may result in loss of permit and possibly result in a citation issued by law enforcement. Excessive late arrival to school may result in permit suspension.
