Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Armada High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was not identified with a label.

The 2023/24 school year was a year that was focused on aligning curriculum and ensuring that all students had access to both academic and social-emotional supports when needed. Armada High School continued with Common Core Standards and curriculum alignment in all classes and continued to work to grow our learning opportunities for students. Staff continued to focus on evidence based instructional strategy implementation and aligning student learning outcomes to competency-based learning models.

In addition, NWEA, PSAT, and M-STEP assessments are used to assist in triangulating data and make informed decisions. All students who successfully complete 8th grade continue to Armada High School

THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN: Armada High School has developed an annual school improvement plan to close the achievement gap among our students in all the core teaching areas. Our school improvement plan targets the areas of math, reading and writing, grading and reporting practices, and relationships

6. IDENTIFY THE NUMBER AND PERCENT OF STUDENTS REPRESENTED BY PARENTS AT PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES: . In the 2023/24 school year, there were approximately 530 students enrolled in Armada High School. We had 134 parents (25.2 %) take part in Fall conferences.
7. FOR HIGH SCHOOLS, ONLY ALSO REPORT ON THE FOLLOWING:
  - a. THE NUMBER AND PERCENT OF POSTSECONDARY ENROLLMENTS 178 students were enrolled in postsecondary courses. This is approximately 33% of Armada High School Students. These students are enrolled in courses that are awarded credit through Ferris State University as well as Dual enrollment courses through Macomb Community College. This does not include our year 13 students that are enrolled in the Early College Program through Macomb Community College.

- b. THE NUMBER OF COLLEGE EQUIVALENT COURSES OFFERED: 14
- c. THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN COLLEGE EQUIVALENT COURSES: 149 Students were enrolled in 1 or more AP courses, this is approximately 28% of our students.
- d. THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS RECEIVING A SCORE LEADING TO COLLEGE CREDIT: 224 AP tests were given to 125 students. 123, or 55% of these tests received a score of 3 or higher.
